

Curriculum Overview

ACADEMIC YEAR 2017 - 2018

Ash Hill Academy provides education for students aged from 11-19 years and is firmly committed to the principle of providing a broad and balanced curriculum for all students. The academy aims to provide the highest quality of learning and teaching.

Students at Ash Hill Academy follow a two year Key Stage 3 programme (Years 7 & 8) and a three year Key Stage 4 programme (Years 9, 10 & 11). Students opt and specialise at the end of Year 8 and will choose another option as they go into Year 11.

Key Stage 3

In Key Stage 3, students follow a broad and balanced curriculum including a wide range of subjects: English, Maths, Science, Geography, History, French, Religious Studies/Life, Design & Technology, Performing Arts, Art, ICT and Physical Education. The number of hours studied is detailed in the table below. Students who require further support with literacy will receive specialist assistance instead of studying a French. Students may be re-integrated into French if it is felt that they have made sufficient progress with their literacy skills.

During Year 8, students will choose to study from History, Geography and French and will study this subject until the end of Year 11. They will also choose two option subjects which they will study in Years 9 and 10. A further subject will be chosen as students go into Year 11. Where appropriate, students are also given the opportunity to study Triple Science. Students are able to choose subjects from a wide range of academic, technical and creative qualifications.

In order to ensure that students study a curriculum which is bespoke to the individual, we ask students to select their subjects from a list rather than from fixed option blocks. This enables us to provide a Key Stage 4 curriculum which is a "best fit" for each student.

Year 9

Due to the demands of studying both English Language and English Literature, Year 9 sees an increase in time given to English lessons. Students also receive an extra hour of science teaching.
