

YEAR 7 Catch Up Impact Statement 2018 to 2019

Ash Hill Academy identifies Year 7 catch-up students using KS2 SATS outcomes; any child achieving less than the National Average in English (104) and/ or maths (105) is entitled to catch up support with the aim of rapidly closing learning gaps.

In 2018/19 academic year, Ash Hill Academy received £17,682 Year 7 Catch-Up Premium.

During this period the following was identified:

A wide range of provision and intervention strategies were offered to enable all learners to engage in learning and do their best. In 2018/19 this funding was used towards:

- Small group Lexia sessions with a specialist teacher for students with dyslexia/ dyslexic traits.
- Dyslexia testing.
- Additional small group English.
- Additional small group maths.
- Teacher training to ensure every teacher can support the development of literacy and numeracy skills.
- Bridge peer mentoring reading program.
- Form time reading challenges.
- 1:1 tuition
- A proportion of Teaching Assistant salaries.
- Behaviour for learning program
- Numeracy Ninja's
- Homework support club.
