To disband (verb)

Definition:

1. (With reference to an organised group) break up or cause to break up.

Week commencing 18th October 2021

Root: late 16th century: from obsolete French desbander.

Synonyms:

1. Break up, disperse, demobilise, dissolve, scatter.
